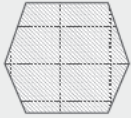

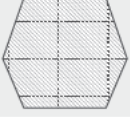

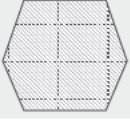

Yalnız gideceğim." karşılığını veriyor. Jessy'nin son konuşmasından Sasha'nın Jessy'nin davetini reddettiği sonucuna ulaşıyoruz. 7. Çözüm

Karşılıklı konuşmada Kimmy, Carla'ya havanın çok güzel olduğunu söyleyerek birlikte piknik yapma teklifinde bulunuyor. Ancak Carla teklif için teşekkür ederek ailesi ile bir planı olduğunu söyleyip bu teklifi reddediyor. Demek ki boşluğa "Carla teklifi reddediyor ve sebep gösteriyor" ifadesinin getirilmesi gerekir. Doğru cevap D seçeneğidir.

8. Çözüm

Metinde Chris hafta içi günlük rutininden bahsediyor. Öğleden sonra saat 4'ten 6'ya kadar okul sonrası aktivitelerini takip ettiğini söylüyor. Film kulübü ve müzik kulübüne katıldığını ve kulüplerde zaman geçirmeyi sevdiğini çünkü film izlemenin ve müzik dinlemenin hobileri olduğundan bahsediyor. 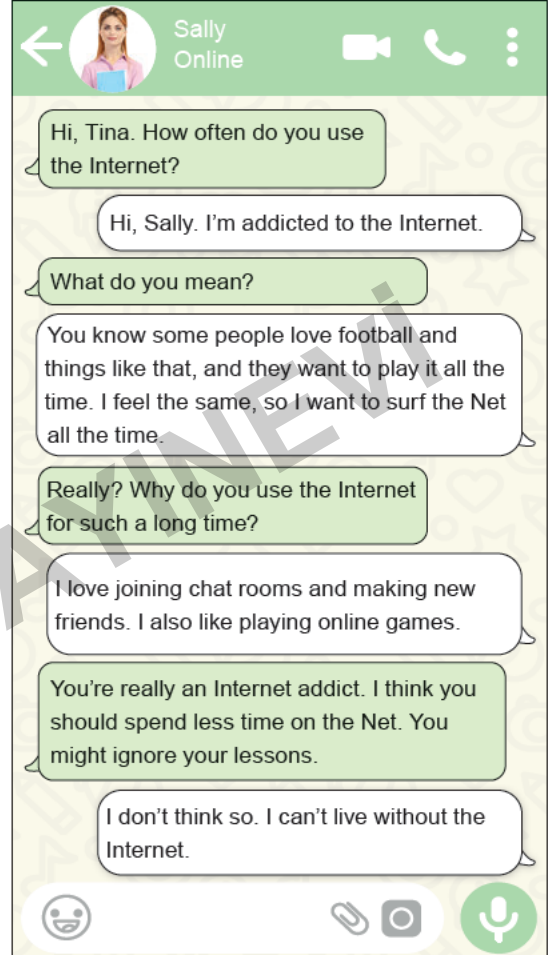

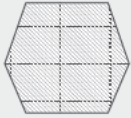
