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ÖN SÖZ

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Biz Data Yayınları olarak kitaplarımızda yaptığımız köklü değişikliklerle yeni sistemin öğrencilere kazandırmak istediği algılama, yorumlama ve sonuca bağlama aşamalarını benimsetmeye çalıştık. Bunu nasıl mı yaptık? Öncelikle yeni sisteme ayak uydurmak adına analiz temelli görsellerle zenginleştirilmiş kurguya dayalı beceri temelli yeni nesil sorular ürettik. Soruları, kurgu potansiyeli yüksek bir yazar kadrosu ve alanında yetkin bir dizgi ekibiyle hazırladık. Soruları hazırlarken, öğrencilerin algılarını soru üzerinde yoğunlaştırarak derinleştirmek ve genel kültürlerini arttırmak amacıyla soruları zenginleştirdik. Bazen de güncel olaylardan seçmeye özen gösterdik.

Eğitim tek yönlü kazanımları değil, bir olgu diriktir. Biz Data Yayınları olarak bu bilinçle hazırladığımız bu beceri temelli yeni nesil sorularla öğrencileri çok yönlü bir eğitim kampına alıyoruz. Bir yandan öğrencinin düşünme becerisini en üst noktaya taşıırken bir yandan da öğrenciye günlük yakalama fırsatını veriyoruz. Ayrıca yeni nesil sorularla öğrencilerin zamanı bilinçli kullanmalarını ve eğlenerek soru çözmelerini sağlıyoruz. Güncel olaylardan yola çıkarak hazırladığımız, uzman yazar kadromuzun deneyimli kalemiyle buluşan beceri temelli yeni nesil soru kalıplarımız öğrencinin algılama, anlamlandırma ve sonuca bağlama sürecinde oldukça etkili bir rol üstleniyor.

Beceri temelli yeni nesil soruları kitaplarımıza nasıl yerleştirdik? Bir de ona bakalım. Çoğunlukla tam ve yarım sayfa sorular olmakla birlikte çeyrek sayfa sorularımız da mevcuttur. Testlerimizi, beceri temelli yeni nesil sorular ve kazanım tarzındaki sorularla harmanlayarak oluşturduk. Testlere eklediğimiz bu beceri temelli yeni nesil sorular ile öğrencinin hem peş peşe gelen kazanım soru klişesinden uzaklaşıp eğlenerek soru çözmelerini sağlamayı hem de yeni sistemde var olan algılama ve yorumlama kapasitesini geliştirmeyi amaçladık.

Hangi gün hangi derslerimizin olduğunu söylemek için " **Simple Present Tense** (Geniş Zaman)" yapısı ile birlikte " **have/has** (have got/has got)" fiilini kullanırız. Öznenin 3. tekil şahıs (David, Mary, the cat, he, she, it, etc.) olduğu olumlu cümlelerde " **has / has got**" kullanılırken diğer özneler için " **have / have got**" kullanılır.

Steve: Which classes do you have on Thursday?

Wendy: I have science, geography, music and double maths.

Ryan: Does your sister have social studies on Monday?

Betty: Yes, she has social studies on Monday. / Yes, she does.

EXPRESSING LIKES AND DISLIKES

Sevdiğimiz, hoşlandığımız şeylerden bahsederken " **like, love, enjoy**" fiillerini kullanırız. Bu fiillerin kullanımında Simple Present Tense (Geniş Zaman) kuralları geçerlidir.

Examples:

I like maths and science.

She loves physical education and music.

Sevmediğimiz, hoşlanmadığımız şeylerden bahsederken " **don't / doesn't like, dislike, hate**" adelerini kullanırız.

Examples:

Robert doesn't like history and art.

We hate geography and music.

NOTE

Öznenin 3. tekil şahıs olduğu olumlu cümlelerde " **like, love, enjoy, dislike, hate**" fiillerine " **-s**" takısı eklenir.

NOTE

" **Like, love, enjoy, don't / doesn't like, dislike, hate**" den sonra gelen fiillerin sonuna " **-ing**" takısı eklenir.

Examples:

They like solving problems.

Kate dislikes doing experiments.

Birine en sevdiği şeyin ya da şeylerin ne olduğunu sormak istediğimizde " **What is/are your favourite...?**" soru kalıbını kullanırız.

Example:

Chris: What is your favourite class?

Emma: My favourite class is English. / It is English.

NOTE

Bir şeyde iyi olduğumuzu söylemek için " **be good at**" ifadesini kullanırız. Kötü olduğumuz şeyler için ise " **be bad at**" ifadesini kullanırız. Bu ifadelerden sonra gelen fiile " **-ing**" takısı eklenir.

Examples:

I'm good at music, but I'm bad at art.


My brother is good at learning new languages.

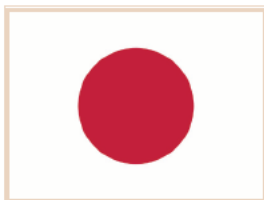

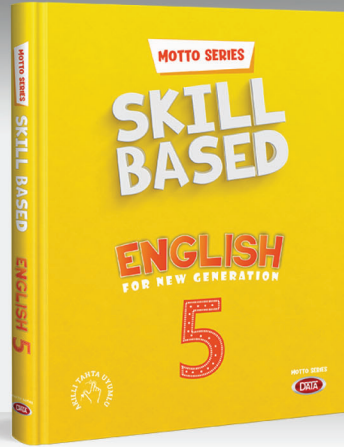
