$\uparrow$ He doesn't help his mother at home after school. (O, okuldan sonra evde annesine yardım etmez.)
$\rightarrow$ Does Tom (he) play football at weekends? (Tom (O) hafta sonları futbol oynar mı?)
$\checkmark$ "Wh- questions"larda cümle kurulumu şöyledir:

$\rightarrow$ A: What do you do before you go to bed? (Yatmaya gitmeden önce ne yaparsın?) B: I write my diary. (Günlüğümü yazarım.)
$\rightarrow$ A: What time does he get up on weekdays? ( O , hafta içleri saat kaçta kalkar?)
B: He gets up at half past seven on weekdays. (O, hafta içleri saat yedi buçukta kalkar.)

## Telling The Time and Dates

$\checkmark$ Saatin kaç olduğunu sormak için "What time is it?" veya "What is the time?" soru kalıplarını kullanırız. Bu sorulara cevap verirken tam saatler için "o'clock", buçuk saatler için "half past", çeyrek kala için "quarter to" ve çeyrek geçe için "quarter past" ifadelerini kullanırız.
$\rightarrow$ A: What time is it?
B: It is nine o'clock.

$\begin{aligned} \rightarrow & \text { A: What is the time? } \\ & \text { B: It is quarter past ten. }\end{aligned}$
