NEDEN BİR TIK ZOR?

Yeni çağ, bilgiyi akılda tutmayı değil edinilen bilgiyi günlük hayatta kullanmayı, davranışa ve pratiğe dökmeyi gerekli kılıyor. Bu doğrultuda eğitim sistemi de yenilikten bağımsız düşünülemez. Çağımızın gerektirdiği yeni eğitim sisteminde, davranış odaklı kazanımlar bütün bilgi dallarında yepyeni bir ölçme ve değerlendirme yaklaşımını da beraberinde getirmektedir.

Değişen sınav sistemi, sorularda, okuma-anlama düzeyini ve muhakeme yeteneğini ön plana çıkarmaktadır. Yayımlanan örnek sorular da göstermektedir ki bir metinden birden fazla soru sorma geleneği devam edeceği gibi sınavda görselleri yorumlama da ön planda olacaktır. Bu kitabın klasik soru bankalarından farkı nedir?

- Soru bankamız, MEB'in aylık olarak yayımladığı örnek sorular ve çıkmış sınav sorularıyla hem yapı hem de mantık olarak birebir özdeş hatta "bir tık daha zor" sorulardan oluşmaktadır. Zor gayreti gerektirir, gayret de başarıyı getirir. Sınavda % 1 ile % 10'luk dilimde siz de yer almak istiyorsanız biliniz ki "zor"la yüzleşmelisiniz.
- Tekrar hatırlatalım artık sadece salt ezber bilgiye ve teoriye dayalı sorular sorulmamaktadır. Bu yüzden kitapta mantık yürütme, yorumlama, görsel okuma, çözümleme, farklı yaklaşımlarla sonuca gitme becerilerini geliştirmeye yönelik soru örnekleriyle karşılaşacaksınız.
- Bu kadarı yeterli mi? Tabi ki değil. Sorular, MEB İngilizce müfredatının kazanımları çerçevesinde tasarlandı.
 Çok çeşitli soru kombinasyonları, sınavın havasını teneffüs etmenizi hatta bir tık önde olmanızı sağlayacaktır.


