





GREAT MOSQUE AND HOSPITAL OF DİVRİĞİ


The complex of the Great Mosque of Divriği consists of a mosque, a hospital and a tomb. The Great Mosque was built by Ahmet Shah, and the hospital was built by his wife Turan Melek during the time of the Mengujekid Beylik in Divriği of Sivas Province in central eastern Turkey. Construction was begun in 1228 and completed in 1243. Hurrem Shah of Ahlat was the chief architect of those structures. But what makes this building too special and important?

It is the most important sample of early Islamic-Turkish architecture with its incredible wall ornaments, the acoustic walls of hospital side to treat the patients and the praying man and woman figures' shadows appear on the two gates of the mosque in summer time. 




